As part of #teamHDFT's Sustainability agenda, HIF developed our "Green Plan 2022-2025", which was approved in March 2022.

The plan, which initially covers the next three years, sets out the key areas we need to focus on, for instance to significantly reduce carbon emissions across our footprint by developing schemes that support walking and cycling, enhance green spaces, reduce pollutants and waste,

improve energy efficiency and increase recycling.

The plan will help us to become a greener, more sustainable organisation, which will also lead to financial benefits. Delivering our green objectives will lead to reduced running costs and the savings can be used to support improvements in patient care.

It will also start us on our journey to be "carbon net-zero". You may be aware that the UK Government has committed to achieving carbon net-zero emissions by 2050. This is a mandatory target, set by the Climate Change Act 2008. The NHS has acknowledged its significant contribution to UK carbon emissions and has therefore set a target to become carbon net-zero by 2040.

We will continue to update you on our progress with this, upcoming projects and

how you can get involved over the coming months. One project that has recently been completed is our fantastic cycle shed.

Our state of the art cycle storage features space for 44 bikes and contains a tool kit station plus two charging points for electric bikes and is only accessible by staff with specified permission, for

added security.

We have also been working on enhancing all of our green spaces, especially following the donation of some fantastic flowers, which were award winners at BBC Gardeners World Live! Thank you to our HIF colleagues and wonderful Volunteer Gardeners for your work!

Kayte previously worked for the Facilities department at North


Yorkshire County Council and came to HIF because she wanted to find a teamoriented and supportive environment, where she could make a difference.




