2. Project Summary:					
Delivery:	Good progress continues to be made with AHU replacement, desteaming and pumping. Window replacement works have progress significantly and the re roofing is now complete except for the two RAAC roof corridors. PV panels have been installed above Wensleydale and are operational. Works for the borehole have paused due to reduced water extraction rates. The programme dates are being reviewed due to the late approval of the roof plantroom works. Budget:	The project budget has been reduced as indicated above due to the works extending beyond 31/3/22 and XXXXXXXXXXXXXX not funding any labour costs after this date. All funds have been received from XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX

Benefit Realisation:	The 2 projects are anticipated to deliver a reduction in carbon emissions of £500 tCO2 and support the NHS journey to Net Zero emissions. All the design packages are complete and the final calculations being prepared for submission to XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX				

3. Project Status:

Red – behind delivery against plan and not expected to recover against the plan Amber – behind delivery against plan but is expected to get back on track Green – progressing according to plan and within tolerance

Current project status:	Due to the delay in approval of the roof plantroom works the works now extend into March 23, which is beyond the agreed extension. This effects the theatres and day surgery vent plant replacement and decanting of Wensleydale ward. The remainder of the project will be completed within the agreed programme. Due to low water extraction rates the borehole works will not be competed in September, this is now projected for December 2022.
Previous project status: Feb 22	Due to the delay in approval of the roof plantroom works the works now extend into March 23, which is beyond the agreed extension. This effects the theatres and day surgery vent plant replacement and decanting of Wensleydale ward. The remainder of the project will be completed within the agreed programme.
Reason for current status:	Approval of the plantrooms received on the 23 rd May rather than the 4 th April Need to drill the borehole deeper due to low water extraction rates.
Anticipated Project End Date:	Q3 2022/23 for the majority of works – Q4 2022/23 for the roof plantrooms, Q3 2022/23 for the borehole

Achievements:

- BMS replacement works 75% completed, commissioning underway
- Window replacement works continuing across the site
- Roof replacement works completed except RAAC areas
- Air handling unit replacement remains on programme except in new plant rooms
- Pumping and desteam works progressing well
- Replacement pump installation programme ongoing
- Replacement plate heat exchangers ongoing.
- DX control works completed
- Borehole drilling has reached original target depth, water quality and extraction rate tests completed

Slippage:

3 months due to low water extraction rates from the borehole

There is potential £ xxxxxxxxxxx overspend pressure on the overall project budget because of

- Significant additional costs associated with asbestos removal required to allow window surveys to be undertaken.
- Elements of engineering system upgrade to provide additional heat to service the equipment being installed as part of separate ward upgrade works.
- Changes to the glazing specification relating to window restrictors, this requires further validation.
- Design costs associated with the roof plantrooms
